ANNUAL MEETING SUMMARY:

- Thank you for your attendance at the meeting. Thank you for participating in the Consistory election via absentee ballot (19 ballots) and regular ballot (54 ballots) at the meeting. Election results: Elders for 2024-2026 Gawin Kooistra & Ray Krossman. Deacons for 2024-2026 Jeni Ritz & Caleb Van Den Einde and for 2024 to fill an unexpired term, Sharon Dragt.
- The 2024 Budget was approved as presented.
- Note on various designated funds: The Consistory approved closing a couple funds. The Church Sign fund \$145.56 and the Building fund \$4,604.12 balances will be transferred to the General Fund effective January 1, 2024.
- Note on Food Pantry. Earlier in 2023 we removed the outside food pantry because of abuse by one person and misuse of dropping off outdated items. During the summer of 2023 people coming into the church for food declined to 2 or 3 a month and the food we had on shelves was going out of date. Because of these reasons our food pantry is no longer active. If you have been giving financially or through food donations in the past--thank you; however, we don't have a need for future gifts at this time.
